YIP (Your Ideas to Practice) is a program to promote Research and development regarding Water Conflicts among young students; which was introduced in collaboration between SRH University, Heidelberg & UNIVA.

YIP consists of four project-oriented events:

- An online Hackathon,
- Study visit in Germany,
- Practical training in Mexico (UNIVA), and
- A final conference.

The participants are selected by their respective university committees, based on factors such as interest in intercultural communication, personal motivation, a high affinity for the topics, excellent study performance, and English language skills (minimum Level of B2 required).

Participants will work on sustainable developments and innovative ideas for water resource management in the Lago de Chapala and the Rio Lerma, in order to eliminate any future conflicts, or at the least, to restrict. At the same time, students will also get more exposure to the cycle of practical projects and will get more experience regarding international project management which is a significant topic these days. Joining to these projects will also help students in independent working skills.
