The „Danube connects“-project promotes environmental awareness and education through a combination of scientific and practical approaches. The project is dedicated to developing, testing, and disseminating innovative environmental education formats for young people in the Danube region, with the goal of raising their awareness of environmental and climate protection, familiarizing them with scientific and technical methods, and fostering their civic engagement.

Young people in Germany and Serbia gain experience in collecting environmental data, are made aware of air and water pollution in the Danube region, and are motivated to protect the environment.

In addition, teachers and youth education initiatives are strengthened through capacity building, and networking with partner institutions in the Danube region is promoted.

Danube Connects pursues three sub-goals:

1. Exchange, (further) development, and testing of environmental education formats for young people
2. Strengthening civic engagement in the Danube region
3. Establishing and strengthening international partnerships in the Danube region
